The background represents the things that get in the way of me being successful. The to do list and infinity sign represent my neverending list of things to do. The zzz's represent my occassional laziness and love of sleeping and relaxing. The brain represents that I have a hard time focusing and that I tend to overthink things. The shadow monster represents anxiety and fear of failure that sometimes keeps me from trying new things.
